VIRTUAL 3D TOUR THROUGH THE TITIAN HALL OF THE KUNSTHISTORISCHES MUSEUM VIENNA

From 1 October 2021, the Kunsthistorisches Museum Vienna is offering a new virtual 3D tour through one of the world's most famous painting collections via the digital platform *Discover Culture* under the title ***The Imperial Titian Collection***: Gallery VIII of the museum's Picture Gallery houses works by the Italian artist Tiziano Vecellio, called Titian, and can now be experienced completely digitally with the new offer.

The 3D tour offers art enjoyment in the highest resolution. Visitors can enjoy the special atmosphere in this room from the comfort of their own home and still experience Titian's art up close: using the zoom function (+ and -), the paintings can also be viewed at close range. Information about the works of art and their creators can be found directly in the virtual room. Art educators tell about Venice in the 16th century and about the life of Titian.

The Kunsthistorisches Museum Vienna, whose Picture Gallery emerged from the art collections of Habsburgs, has the second largest Titian collection in the world after the Prado in Madrid, with over 25 works by the Venetian master. The 3D tour offers
